Facial asymmetry:

RISK OR RESULT
of stroke, Bell's Palsy,
viral infection HSV-1
(cold sore virus), EBV,
Herpes Zoster (chicken pox/shingles)

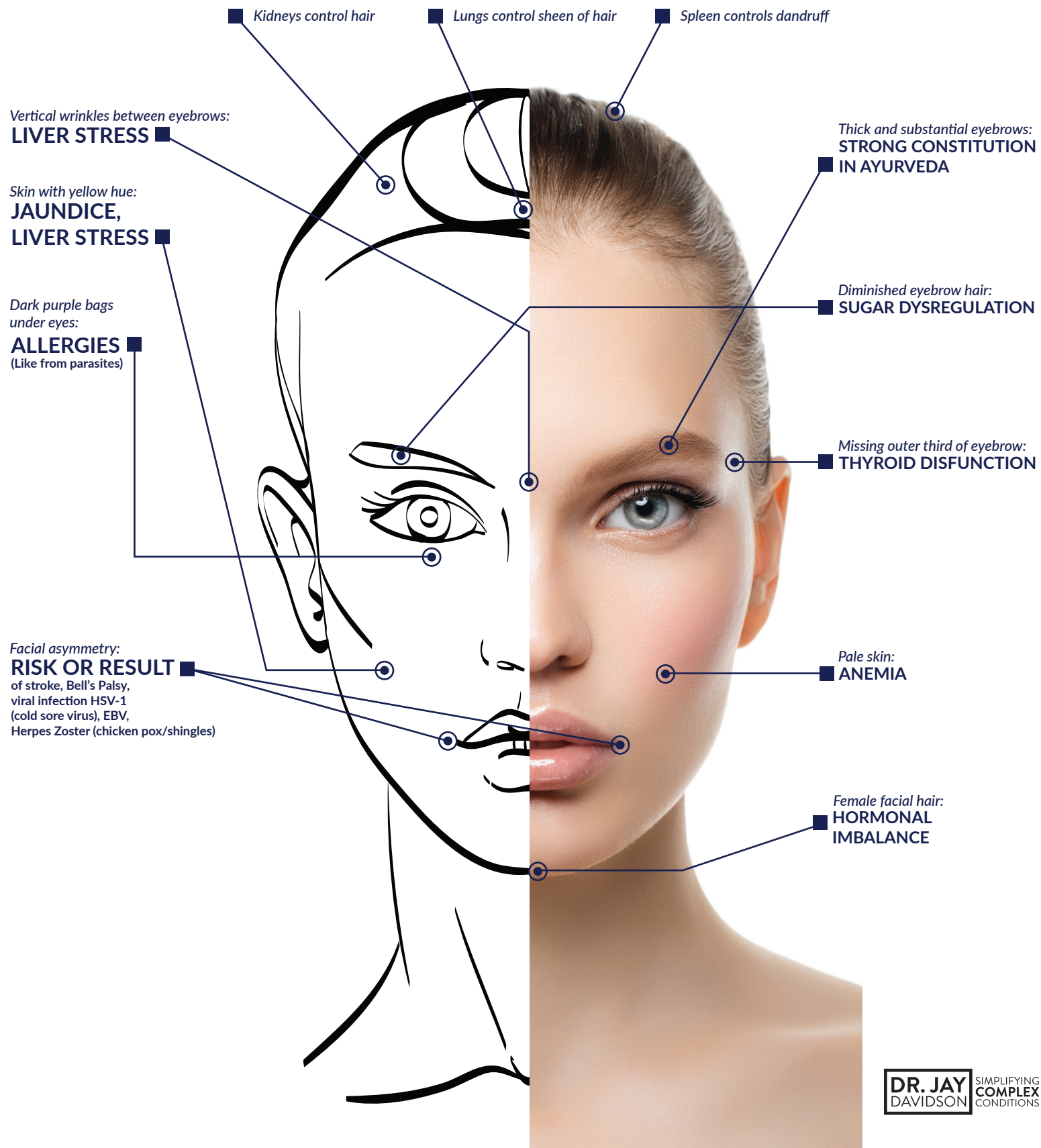
Thick and substantial eyebrows:

Diminished eyebrow hair:
SUGAR DYSREGULATION

Missing outer third of eyebrow:
THYROID DISFUNCTION

Pale skin:
ANEMIA

**HORMONAL
IMBALANCE**
